

## Abstract

Hebrew Reminders is a simple sidebar notification that informs your users of upcoming Anniversary, Birthday and Yahrzeit dates for Contacts based on Hebrew calendar dates.

## Description

Some businesses work with contacts and find that remembering an important Hebrew date such as an Anniversary, Birthday, or Yahrzeit (remembrance of a death) will enhance that relationship with that particular person/business.

Hebrew Reminders is a simple yet effective Salesforce component, which incorporates the notification of relevant Hebrew dates into your existing Salesforce org.

When you install Hebrew Reminders you will receive the quantifiable benefit of time savings. Your users will no longer need to manually manipulate the occurrence of an important Hebrew date into a Gregorian date because this component does the logic for you. In addition, your users will only need to enter the Hebrew date one time because the component will determine the corresponding Gregorian date as it reoccurs over time.

The unobtrusive design of the Hebrew Reminders component means that there is no downtime for training on the functionality. Your users will be able to use the component as soon as it is installed with little more than a message outlining the high-level concept of how the application works.

The functionality of Hebrew Reminders allows your users to configure the notifications to meet their personal needs. Each user can configure the component to display reminders for all contacts or just the contacts that they own. Each user also has the ability to customize the timeframe on reminders. They can be reminded as early as 99 days before a reminder date or as late as one day prior.

The Hebrew Reminders component is available for a one-time fee of \$500.00 USD and can be installed into your Salesforce org for a trial period of 15 days. Once Hebrew Reminders is purchased you can receive updated versions of the component as they become available for a significantly discounted price.

## Features & Benefits

- Associate Anniversary, Birthday, and Yahrzeit dates directly to your contacts using either the Hebrew or Gregorian calendar.
- Be notified, via sidebar component, when these important recurring dates are approaching.
- Set the notifications to occur on the Gregorian or Hebrew date of the event.
- Allow each user in your org to customize the reminders as they see fit.
  - Each user can customize the functionality to show "All Contacts" or only "My Contacts."
  - Each user can customize the functionality to be alerted from 1 to 99 days in advance of the date.
